

**Dr. Gavriel D. Kohlberg** is Associate Professor and Chief of Otology and Neurotology in the Department of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Washington, specializing in otology, neurotology, and lateral skull base surgery. He earned his B.A. in Computer Science from Harvard University and his M.D. from Stanford University, followed by residency at New York Presbyterian Columbia and Cornell and fellowship at the University of Cincinnati.

His interdisciplinary collaborations span computer science, linguistics, and engineering, advancing technologies to improve speech understanding in noisy environments. He is a recipient of the American Otological Society Clinician Scientist Award and has been awarded multiple grants supporting technologic innovations.

Dr. Kohlberg has served as examiner for both general otolaryngology and neurotology boards and holds leadership positions on committees of the American Neurotology Society.
